Almost 6 months of organic, healthy, local, fresh veggies coming up!



We are in full swing here at Iowana Farm. We put up a new high tunnel last fall, thanks to our two 16 year old neighbor boys Casey and Andrew. The high tunnel (looks like a greenhouse but no heat or forced air ventilation) is 30' x 60' and was covered in plastic in November. We had lots of help from neighbors and family pulling the plastic in place.

The tunnel has been planted with spinach, kale, cauliflower, cabbage, broccoli, chard and lettuce. They were planted beginning in late February and finished up in early March. Last weekend we planted more in the small garden patch (40' x 75') north of the tunnel as well as turnips, radishes, beets and carrots. A rabbit fence surrounds all.



April Schedule

Heirloom tomatoes will go into the south high tunnel the first week in April. Potatoes are planted on Good Friday, or so the saying goes. This actually follows planting by the moon (by definition a waning moon after the first full moon after March 21). Roots go in on a waning moon. So we will be adding carrots, beets, turnips, parsnips and radishes like crazy. And if the weather holds, we will start our first planting of sweet corn in late April.

Unlike traditional menu planting where we decide what to make and then go buy it at the supermarket, with the CSA we get the stuff in a box and then have to go find the recipes.
