This is our first pack of the Fall CSA 2012! We have cabbage, kale and chard. We also have sweet peppers, tomatoes, summer squash and eggplant picked last Friday just before the first hard freeze. We also have sweet potatoes and culinary sage in the pack.

Early Killing Frost







We have had several hard frosts in the last week that have killed all of the tomatoes, peppers, squash and eggplants.

Here Cindy and Jacqueline are removing clips that hold tomato vines to the trellis. Casey and Yura are pulling up the trellis fence and then the stakes.

We are putting up a new high tunnel (looks like a greenhouse but we grow in the field dirt and there is no heat or forced air ventilation). The high tunnels improve product availability and stability for the CSA.

What's Next

Next week we will have lettuces and broccoli side shoots added to the pack. We picked massive numbers of green tomatoes just before the frost. We will add them, as well as sweet peppers, to the pack as they ripen. Not the quality of vine ripened tomatoes, but still much better than store bought. There is also butternut squash!

Pack 2

This pack we have broccoli side shoots, butternut squash, kale, chard and oregano. The tomatoes were picked green two weeks ago and have ripened with their stems on in the packing room. The story with the sweet peppers is the same. The spinach and lettuces are just reaching the harvest stage and are combined in one bag.

Most of our product is coming from the high tunnel erected last fall.

The broccoli side shoots are coming from plants we harvested the main central head from in June. The cool weather wakes them up!

New High Tunnel Update

We decided to change location for the new high tunnel! It is pictured here in the north field. From front to back you see the deer fence, Asparagus patch 2, potato, pepper and sweet potato fields ready for winter cover crops and the site. In the center is the machine shed and behind it is the herb house and potting shed. To the right is the south east corner of the high tunnel erected last year. It still has insect screen on the side. It was replaced with plastic Sunday.

Amazingly, we still have green ripened tomatoes and sweet peppers for the pack. New to the pack are purple top turnips. These are fall turnips and very sweet. They are so sweet they and delicious raw and do not have to be cooked. Also in the pack are sweet potatoes, kale, chard, spinach, lettuce and sorrel.

Sweet Potato Humus and Sorrel



I had a tip about sweet potato humus from share holder Pam when she visited our booth at Village Pointe last month. Wow! Delicious with broccoli and peppers!

We have also added a little herbaceous green called sorrel to the pack. This is European sorrel and not American sorrel. It grows from Scotland to the Baltic and is savored for its sour lemony flavor. It pairs well with eggs, cream, potatoes and fish. It is often an ingredient is soups. Adding bits of it to salad greens is delightful. Stand alone fresh think sweet and sour.

Arugula, Sweet Potatoes and Turnips



There is arugula in the pack. It is turning very nutty. Arugula is very spicy, with strong flavors of black pepper and hot Chinese mustard and mellow walnuts. The spice is balances with vinaigrette. A recipe using avocados and grapefruit is included.

The sweet potatoes are starting to go south. Blemishes are still cosmetic at this point. They are still delicious, but try to each them soon.

The fall turnips are very sweet due to the cold nights. Be sure to try them raw. They can be cut up and put in salads.

Work continues on the new high tunnel. Casey is pictured here taping couplings with Gorilla tape. Sharp corners have to be covered to keep the plastic from tearing on windy days. 
